

Parent Guide to Choosing Online Tuition in Thanjavur

Choosing tuition is one of the more expensive and consequential decisions a parent makes, and it is usually made with very little information. This guide is written for parents in Thanjavur district. It gives you the questions to ask any tuition provider, the warning signs to walk away from, and a practical checklist for setting your child up to learn well at home. It applies whether or not you choose F2A Math School.

Twelve questions to ask any tuition provider

Ask these before paying anything. A provider confident in their teaching will answer all of them directly.

- ☐ Exactly how many students are in the batch my child would join? Ask for a number, not a range like small batches.
- ☐ Are classes live, or recorded videos with a doubt forum attached?
- ☐ Who is the actual teacher for my child, and what are their qualifications in this subject?
- ☐ Will the same teacher stay with the batch for the full year, or do teachers rotate?
- ☐ Which board and syllabus does the teaching follow, and are batches separated by board?
- ☐ How often are assessments held, and what exactly do I receive as a parent afterwards?
- ☐ What happens when my child misses a class?
- ☐ How are doubts handled between classes, and what is the realistic response time?
- ☐ Can I attend a free demo of a real class before deciding?
- ☐ What is the total fee for the year, and what is not included in it?
- ☐ What is the refund policy if we stop after a month?
- ☐ Can I speak to a current parent whose child is in the same class as mine?

Warning signs worth walking away from

- Guaranteed marks or guaranteed ranks. No honest teacher can promise this, because the outcome depends on the student.
- Pressure to pay immediately, or a discount that expires today.
- Refusal to let you observe a live class before enrolling.
- Vague answers about batch size. This almost always means the batch is large.
- No written assessment or progress reporting to parents.
- A named star teacher used in the marketing who does not actually teach your batch.

What good live online tuition looks like

Batch size	Small enough that every student is asked to solve and explain during the session. Beyond roughly eight students this stops happening.
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Interaction	The student speaks, writes and solves on screen. Watching a screen silently for an hour is not a class.
Assessment	Regular written tests on the exam pattern, with feedback that names the specific weakness rather than just a score.
Parent visibility	Structured updates you receive without having to chase anyone.
Consistency	The same mentor, the same batch, the same weekly time slot for the full year.

Home setup checklist

- ☐ A smartphone, tablet or laptop that the student can use uninterrupted for the full class.
- ☐ A stable internet connection. Test it at the actual class time, not at a quiet hour.
- ☐ Headphones, which improve concentration far more than most parents expect.
- ☐ A fixed study spot with a table, good light and the back to the room rather than facing a doorway.
- ☐ Notebook, textbook, geometry box and a rough pad within reach before the class begins.
- ☐ Phone notifications silenced for the duration of the class.
- ☐ A family agreement that the class hour is not interrupted, in the way an offline class would not be.

Supporting your child without adding pressure

- Ask what was covered today rather than how much did you score. The first question opens a conversation, the second closes it.
- Treat a bad test as information rather than a verdict. The useful question is which specific chapter caused it.
- Protect sleep. A tired student loses more marks to careless errors than to gaps in knowledge.
- Let the mentor handle the teaching. Parents correcting method mid-chapter usually confuses the student.
- Keep the mistake notebook visible at home. It is the single highest-return study habit at this level.
